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### English Verb Tenses Forms

The verbs in all of these sentences refer to the present time, and are, therefore, said to be in the present tense. In sentence 1, however, the verb simply talks about the action. It doesn't state whether the action is complete or not. The verb is therefore said to be in the simple present tense.

In English grammar tenses, both "Will" and "Be Going to" are used to express future tense but they do not have the same meaning. Will is used to express future actions decided at the moment of speaking, while Going to describes future plans decided before the moment of speaking.
